Greetings! Arts Partners is an awesome program funded by your school district to help you integrate arts based education into your curriculum. The district pays all fees—there is no cost to you for these programs!

Some of these programs come to your school, so no transportation is needed. If transportation is needed (e.g., Symphony, Nelson-Atkins Museum of Art, Kemper Museum), the district will pay for and schedule the bus. You must still approve the trip in EduLog even though there will be no cost to your school.

We prepared this worksheet so you know what programs are available to your school and how to schedule them. Keep this worksheet so you have a record of which programs you have scheduled and when they will happen.

Instructions:

- 1. Check to see if these programs have already been scheduled. If you are not sure whether they have been scheduled, talk to your school office, the contacts listed on this worksheet and/or the Arts Partners team at Kansas City Young Audiences (see below).**
- 2. Write down approximately how many students your school has in each grade level in the space provided on the worksheet. You will need to know the number of students when you schedule programs.**
- 3. Check the school calendar. There is a space on the worksheet where you can write down possible dates if you find that useful. Keep the school calendar handy when making your scheduling calls.**
